Through the support of the Kislak Family Foundation, FLC is pleased to announce a new initiative to help low-income adult education and literacy students who do not have home access to a computer or tablet for use on the Internet. If you know students who would benefit in their adult education studies by having a computer, we encourage you to let them know about this opportunity. Selected applicants will receive a free Chromebook, which they will be allowed to keep providing that they regularly attend online or in-person classes or tutoring sessions for four months.

Selected students will receive a <u>Chromebook 3</u> or similar device. Applications will be reviewed on an ongoing basis while supplies last.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Adults in Florida who are currently enrolled in an adult basic education, literacy, or ESOL program and do not have a computer or tablet at home. Students must have reliable home internet access and be eligible to receive SNAP, Medicaid, or Lifeline benefits (see application for income guidelines).

HOW TO APPLY

Students will need to fill out and submit the online application. Their teacher or tutor will need to submit a letter of endorsement with the application to qualify. Each application will be reviewed on its own merits, and we recommend that teachers and students work on the application together. A limited number of awards will be made per program.
