

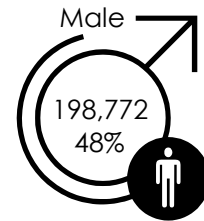
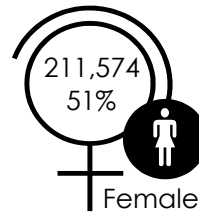

### PROGRAMS PERFORMANCE SUMMARY

- 📖 152,169 (37%) adult students were served in ESOL, the largest program
- 📖 1,877 (.5%) students were served in ESOL high advanced, the smallest program
- 📖 175,960 (43%) students were Hispanic
- 📖 290,893 (71%) students were enrolled below the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level
- 📖 140,960 (34%) students completed a level
- 📖 86,960 (21%) students completed a level and advanced one or more levels
- 📖 20,754 (5%) students earned a GED/high school diploma
- 📖 54,356 (13%) students obtained employment – a 37% increase over previous year
- 📖 4,176 (1%) students entered postsecondary
- 📖 251,745 (61%) students were unemployed when they entered the program – a 19% decline
- 📖 34,044 (8%) students were on public assistance when enrolled – decline of 1,000 students in this population
- 📖 42,896 (10%) students were in correctional/institutional settings
- 📖 157,715 (38%) students were in age group 25-44, the largest age group
