





## PROGRAMS PERFORMANCE SUMMARY

- \$\rightarrow\$ 152,169 (37%) adult students were served in ESOL, the largest program
- \$1,877 (.5%) students were served in ESOL high advanced, the smallest program
- \$\rightarrow\$ 175,960 (43%) students were Hispanic
- 290,893 (71%) students were enrolled below the 9th grade level
- \$\iiii 140,960 (34%) students completed a level
- 86,960 (21%) students completed a level and advanced one or more levels
- 20,754 (5%) students earned a GED/high school diploma
- 😂 54,356 (13%) students obtained employment a 37% increase over previous year
- 4,176 (1%) students entered postsecondary
- 251,745 (61%) students were unemployed when they entered the program a 19% decline
- ≈ 34,044 (8%) students were on public assistance when enrolled decline of 1,000 students in this population
- 42,896 (10%) students were in correctional/institutional settings.
