Tutor Ready: A Free Online Resource for Literacy Tutors and Teachers

This webinar will introduce you to Tutor Ready, a set of 30 short online learning plans created for tutors and teachers who work with adults in reading. These research-based lessons provide teach strategies for assessing and teaching tutoring adults in a variety of reading skills, including: phonemic awareness, decoding, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.

Each strategy is illustrated by at least one video showing a tutor working with a literacy learner. Tutor Ready is designed to help instructors at all experience levels effectively work with adult learners to improve their reading skills.
