



Free Flu Vaccines

Walgreens Pharmacy and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) have established a partnership to help **underinsured individuals** obtain an annual influenza vaccination. Each year, Walgreens donates \$15 million in flu vaccines to ensure that everyone can receive and benefit from a seasonal influenza vaccination.

Your organization has two options to distribute the influenza vaccine:



Option 1: You can request a bundle of vouchers for interested students. Students cannot contact Walgreens directly to request a voucher. Students will take their voucher to a local Walgreens to receive their free flu vaccine.

Option 2: You can host an on-site immunization clinic. A Walgreens Pharmacist will visit your organization to give out flu vaccines to uninsured students and those whose insurance does not cover a flu vaccine.

Only students who do not have insurance coverage of a flu vaccine will be eligible for a free vaccine through this program.

No identification is required. Students will have to provide their name, date of birth, and city. Information collected during this flu vaccination program is confidential. See pharmacist for privacy policy.

This vaccine is only available to individuals age 18 and older.

There are certain health conditions that prevent the administration of the influenza vaccine. Pharmacists will discuss these before administering the vaccine.

Students will be required to sign a voucher, fill out the Vaccine Administration Record (VAR), and will receive a copy of the Vaccine Information Sheet (VIS).
